- 1st September 2023 Registration opens
- **15th September 2023** Deadline to apply for modified papers (e.g. enlarged print)
- 29th September 2023, 6pm Registration closes for all tests
- 18th October 2023 Test date

Please note that there is no late registration period after 29th September.

All tests will be paper-based this year.

Unless specific directions on format/word limit are given in an individual task, there are no restrictions on the length or nature submissions.

- Anglo-Saxon, Norse & Celtic
 Take a look at some manuscripts! How is Old English different from the English we speak today?
- Archaeology
 Describe how you might excavate a grave or burial, and explore what it can tell us about the people of the past!
- <u>Computer Science</u>
 Design a new "smart" product to join the "internet of things".
- <u>Economics</u>
 Are financial crises inherent to modern economic growth?
- <u>Education</u>
 Should genetics research have an impact on educational policy?


