We need your help with the Raft Challenge planned for Founders' Day. See p.5 for more information.

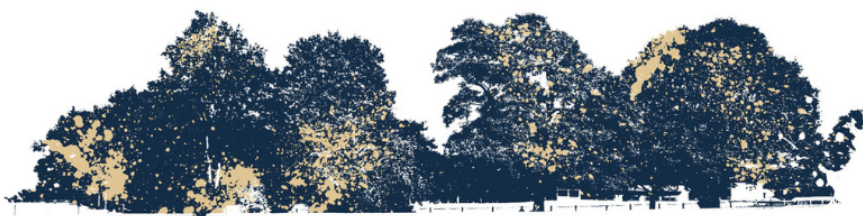

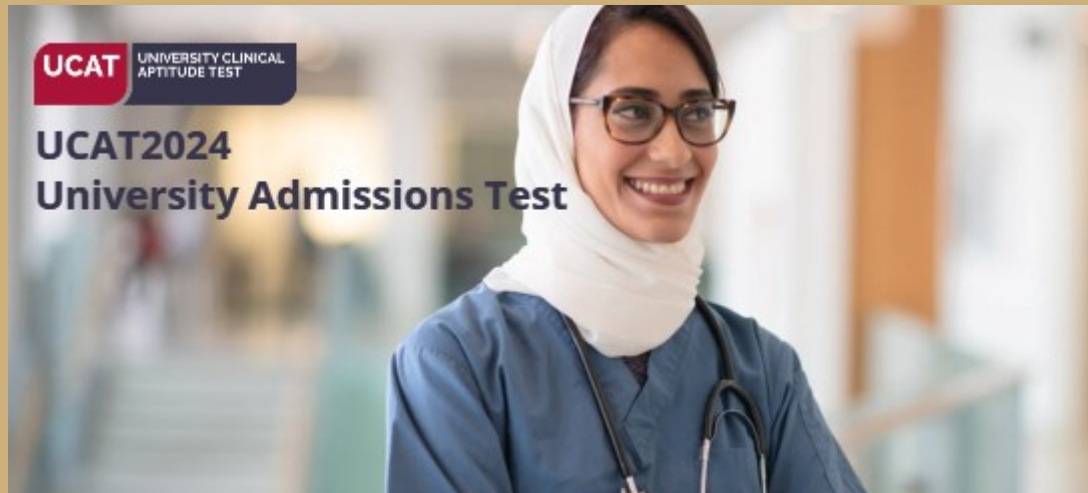

Any students considering applying to study medicine or dentistry need to undertake a University Clinical Aptitude Test (UCAT). UCAT now forms part of the entry requirements for all UK medical and dental schools.

Students applying for 2025 entry must sit the UCAT by **Thursday 26th September 2024**.

UCAT registration is already open and candidates are able to book a test from **Tuesday 18th**

June onwards. Testing takes place between **Monday 8th July** and **Thursday 26th September 2024**.
