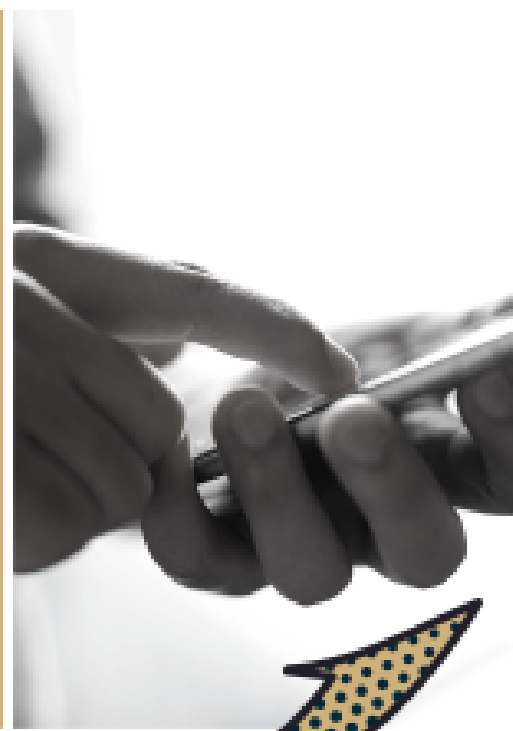
On Thursday 12th January, students will be able to collect their GCSE re-sit results from 6th Form Student services during registration – best of luck!


