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### Minutes / Matters Arising

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### Reports

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Head Teacher's Report:

1. GW briefed the PTA on Lymm High School's academic achievements. A recent Department for Education publication confirms that Lymm High School achieved good results in the last academic year. Of particular note is the score of 0.25 in the progress 8 measure, which analyses the improvement in the pupils' attainment from entering the school to leaving. A score of 0.25 is significantly above average and puts Lymm in the top 20-25% of schools that are similar to Lymm. It also places Lymm in the top 10 schools for this measure in the whole of Cheshire and Warrington. Furthermore, the exam attainment means Lymm is in the top 11-12% of schools in the country.
2. School improvements: Work is progressing on the improvements to the school changing rooms and replacement of the gym floor. GW to communicate this to parents. In addition, in the next few weeks the Santa Dash will be launched which was a successful fundraiser last year.
3. Parent forum 16<sup>th</sup> October: GW found the meeting very useful. A summary of the discussions will be compiled and sent to all parents.

Chair's Report:

The FB page is working well and LH is doing a good job of addressing concerns raised on the page. In general, there have been more positive comments on the page. KJ suggested that when we advertise events on the page, everyone should like and comment if possible on the event as this helps to keep the post towards the top of the FB page feed.

Treasurer's Report:

Nothing has changed since the report delivered at the AGM. A cheque was presented to GW by JC for £945.10 from the Lymm Ladies Lunch.
