Minutes / Matters Arising

The minutes were read and accepted.

Reports

Head Teacher's Report:

- 1. LHS pupils had brilliant GCSE results this year with 90% of students achieving at least "old C" grades in English and maths. The progress 8 score is expected to be ~0.5 or more which is a really strong result. GW is particularly pleased with the depth of performance of pupils over all subjects. Year 10 English literature results were also excellent. LHS will continue to work on improving the exam results of students from less affluent backgrounds.
- 2. New year 7s and new staff have all settled in well. The school is still heavily oversubscribed. GW commented that despite newspaper reports about a crisis in teacher recruitment, LHS does not seem to have problems with recruitment and teachers want to come and work at the school.
- 3. New canopy has been constructed over the McCorm's Yard which has provided some covered seating and helped provide more seating for the canteen.
- 4. At the end of the last academic year LHS was awarded the bid from the FA to build a 3G pitch.
- 5. On the 1st October there will be an advice evening for key stage 3 where some aspects of last year's successful evening on drugs will be replicated for key stage 3.
- 6. LHS will be focusing this year on the theme of social responsibility and what it means to be a socially responsible citizen.

Chair's Report:

It has been a good year where the strategy of having fewer but larger events has worked well. In addition, reducing the frequency of PTA meetings from once half termly to once termly appears to be more efficient too. Instead, employing small groups focused on different events/fundraising streams has been very effective.
