Head Teacher's Report:

- 1. It has been a good start to the year, school feels back to normal, assemblies are back on and an awards evening has been held.
- 2. Coronavirus: There have been ~8 Covid cases in the main school since the start of term and a few more in 6th form.
- 3. Exams: The students did well in GCSE and A-levels exams this summer and results were easier for the school to manage than in 2020.
- 4. Priorities for this year are exam results, maintaining good behaviour standards, getting extracurricular provision back to normal.
- 5. Aiming to provide more training and discussion for students around PSHE/RSE and provide education and awareness evenings for parents and students on drugs, sex and mental health.

Chair's Report:

It has been another unusual year but despite this we have still managed some fundraising and adapted to circumstances by hosting the quiz with the teaching staff on Zoom and putting on the Easter and summer orienteering.

Treasurer's Report:

2020/2021 – The quiz night brought in £1072, orienteering made £235 and the pumpkin challenge made £127 profit. Income from Easy fundraising was £367, gift aid amounted to £114 plus MyDonate/SumUp/donations and bank interest were £101. Accounts provided with minutes.
